The existing committee, and those before us have worked hard to build a safe, friendly and welcoming club for all players (girls and boys) who want to play netball. At the upcoming Annual General Meeting (AGM) all committee positions are declared vacant.

Please show your support by attending the AGM on Wednesday 25th October 2017 at 7:00pm casting the vote to which you are entitled. If you would like to nominate for a position on the 2018 committee please complete the nomination form via the club webpage ([www.quinnsnetballclub.net](http://www.quinnsnetballclub.net)) and send to our club secretary Norae Fisher via [info@quinnsnetballclub.net](mailto:info@quinnsnetballclub.net).

At the AGM, we will be calling a Notice of Motion to amend the Club Constitution.

The notice is to advise a motion to "alter, repeal or add to the constitution" along with a further motion to "accept the proposed alterations, repeals or additions".

Special resolution notice - motion for proposed amendments to the constitution of Quinns Districts Netball Club Inc. January 2016, Annual General Meeting, Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2017.

## **Proposals - Constitution amendments.**

### **Proposal 1:**

#### **Current wording: 4.1.4:**

- The office bearers of the Club will consist of Umpire Coordinator, Coaches Coordinator, Uniform Coordinator, Equipment Coordinator, Fundraising Coordinator.

#### **Proposed wording:**

- The office bearers of the Club will consist of - Umpire Coordinator, Coach & Manager's Coordinator, Uniform Coordinator, Equipment Coordinator, Fundraising Coordinator, Sponsorship & Grants Coordinator.

#### **Reason for proposed change:**

- To create a new position of Sponsorships and Grants. To develop the Coach Coordinator role to include that of the Team Manager.

### **Proposal 2:**

#### **Current wording: 4.1.5:**

- The General Committee members of the Club will be limited to three (3).

#### **Proposed wording: 4.1.5:**

- The General Committee members of the Club will be limited to three (3) senior members and five (5) junior members. A junior General Committee member must be aged (or turning) 14 – 17 years for the committee year in question.

#### **Reason for proposed change:**

- To encourage and allow junior members to understand and become more involved within the running of the Club and develop them toward future roles within the committee.

### **Proposal 3:**

#### **Current wording: 5.1.9**

- Twelve (12) members entitled to vote in accordance with clause 5.1.6 shall constitute a quorum at the AGM. Members entitled to vote must attend the AGM in order to be considered part of the quorum. Proxy votes are not considered part of quorum numbers.

#### **Proposed wording: 5.1.9**

- Ten (10) members entitled to vote in accordance with clause 5.1.6 shall constitute a quorum at the AGM. Members entitled to vote must attend the AGM in order to be considered part of the quorum. Proxy votes are not considered part of quorum numbers.

#### **Reason for proposed change:**

- Decrease the quorum number at the AGM, so to ensure a quorum is achieved.

# SPRING SEASON INFORMATION

Reminder that Spring season commences Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October for 13U - 17U and Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October for 8U – 12U. The JNA Spring season of netball is an 8-week season.

Fixtures are now available on the JNA website.

The game times are as follows: -

**Monday:**

5.15pm - 13U, 17U Div 2 & Div 5

6.30pm – 17U Div 1 & Div 3

7.45pm – 17U Div 4

**Tuesday:**

4.30pm – 8U & 9U

5.45pm – 10U & 11U

7.00pm – 12U

All Matches played in the Spring Competition will be centrally timed. Teams that would normally provide a Timekeeper (2nd named team on fixtures) must still have someone nominated to sit with the other team's Scorer (refer to "Duties of Scorer & Timekeeper").

Each Match (excluding NSG 8U's & 9U's) shall consist of 4 x 12 minute quarters, with a 2-minute interval at  $\frac{1}{4}$  and  $\frac{3}{4}$  times and 3 minutes at  $\frac{1}{2}$  time. The time taken during intervals may be shortened at the discretion of a JNA official.

**NOTE: 9U's** will continue to play under **NSG modified rules** for 2017 Spring season and not full rules as in previous years. This is due to some recent changes to Net Set Go for 2018, as advised by Netball Australia & NIAWA

## THE GREEN SHIRT UMPIRE PROGRAM

The Green Shirt Umpire Program was introduced to netball Associations in 2007 and the program has continued to grow each year since its inception. The Green Shirt Umpire Program aims to:

- Make beginner umpires identifiable, so they are easy to recognise and support
- Promote this program to the netball community to raise awareness and increase the recognition and support of beginner umpires
- Assist in reducing the pressure, lessening abuse and conflict directed towards beginner umpires
- Create a culture of support for these beginner umpires through the education of players, spectators, coaches and the media
- Progress beginner umpires through the National Officiating Accreditation Scheme (NOAS). As the issue of abuse towards umpires is increasing and the number of umpires is decreasing, Netball WA aims to encourage and attain umpires in this sport, by assisting them to move through the Green Shirt Program and into Association Squads.

JNA offer associated clubs the opportunity for club members to take part in the Green Shirt Umpire Program during the Spring season of netball. This season we have 4 new junior umpires moving through the umpire pathway. Green Shirt Umpires are easily identifiable as they wear a green umpire shirt.

During Spring this season, the GS Umpires will be officiating 10U and 11U games.

We request that during the GS program all supporters are mindful that they are beginner umpires, learning their craft and your support and encouragement is essential.



The STSAC (Smarter than Smoking Association Championships) is an annual event held over the June long weekend at the State Netball Centre each year. JNA will be offering our athletes the opportunity to trial for the 2018 squads.

2018 Smarter than Smoking Association Championships (STSAC)

TRIAL INFORMATION – 12U's to Opens

Members are invited to trial for STSAC for 2018

The Association Championships will be held on Saturday 2nd June, Sunday 3rd June and Monday 4th June, 2018 inclusive (June long weekend). The venue is to be confirmed.



The cost for the Championships will be confirmed in due course (approximately \$200). STSAC Merchandise will be available for a further cost. If successful, a non-refundable deposit of \$50 will be required to secure your position in the Association Team and must be paid prior to or at the allocated training session in 2018 (otherwise the position will be offered to another athlete). An Athlete Acceptance and Commitment form will also be required to be completed by each selected athlete (please ensure you understand all requirements).

**Refer to IMPORTANT NOTE below.**

Trials will be held at HBF Arena Joondalup. Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to each session.

Please wear non-club/association clothing – ie netball skirt/skort, black shorts, T-shirt or exercise tank only (no denim). No jewellery, hair to be tied up (no long fringes over eyes). Please ensure socks cover ankles and the correct footwear is worn, with shoes tied up correctly.

Water bottle and healthy snack.

PARENTS are to pick up the child/children at the courts! This is a safety issue; your child/children are not to wait out the front of either venue.

Athletes must attend BOTH trial dates for their age group (trial dates attached). Any prior attendance at Development Clinics, or past selections, does not ensure selection in Association teams. These selections are open trials to all 2018 registered members of Joondalup Netball Association ONLY (refer to eligibility in the JNA Policies & Procedures on the website).

Application forms are to be directed to J.N.A. by Monday 30th October 2017, for those turning 12yrs to 17yrs of age in 2018 or 18yrs & over for Opens; either by mail to Suite 11, Lotteries House, 70 Davidson Tce, Joondalup 6027, or email the signed application form to [joondalupnetball@bigpond.com](mailto:joondalupnetball@bigpond.com).

**NOTE:** Late applications, or applications on the night of the trials, WILL NOT be accepted.

JNA are unable to respond to each application, so please attend dates specified. Refer to website for any possible late changes to dates etc.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Once teams are finalised, athletes must give 100% commitment to attend all training sessions, which will be held on WEDNESDAY nights, and including all three days of the weekend carnival, or their position may be given to another athlete. Training is compulsory and will comprise of approximately 10 or more sessions, commencing mid to late February 2018 – dates and times to be confirmed once teams are selected. If players are unable to attend trials due to illness, AIS, WAIS, State, Region or any other commitments, a letter and/or Doctors note must be put forward, with player's full details, to the JNA office.
